CJET-FM Smiths Falls – Licence renewal

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the commercial radio programming undertaking CJET-FM Smiths Falls, from 1 September 2005 to 31 August 2012.
2. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
3. The licence will be subject to the **conditions** set out in *New licence form for commercial radio stations*, Public Notice CRTC 1999-137, 24 August 1999, with the exception of condition of licence number 10, as well as to the following **condition of licence**:
 - During each broadcast week, the licensee shall broadcast a maximum of 85% hit material as defined in *Revised policy on the use of hits by English-language FM radio stations*, Public Notice CRTC 1997-42, 23 April 1997, as amended from time to time.
4. Because this licensee is subject to the *Employment Equity Act* and files reports concerning employment equity with the Department of Human Resources and Skills Development, its employment equity practices are not examined by the Commission.
