## **CKNG-FM Edmonton – Technical change**

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Corus Premium Television Ltd. (Corus) to change the authorized contours of the radio programming undertaking CKNG-FM Edmonton, by decreasing the antenna height and relocating the transmitter.
- 2. Corus stated that it needs to move CKNG-FM's transmitter because listeners are experiencing difficulty receiving its signal in certain large sectors of the Edmonton area since the launch of the new radio station, CHBN-FM Edmonton<sup>1</sup>.
- 3. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
