Competitive Local Exchange Carrier Tariff

- 1. The Commission received an application by Bell Canada, dated 27 April 2005, requesting approval of its proposed Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) Tariff for interconnection services.
- 2. Bell Canada submitted that the proposed CLEC tariff reflects: (a) the adoption and rerenaming of the Bell West Inc. tariff; (b) the amalgamation of the LondonConnect Inc. tariff; (c) the rates, terms and conditions specified in version 23 of the CLEC Model Tariff; and (d) the inclusion of item 601, Service Charge for Trouble Identification on ILEC Unbundled Local Loops, which the Commission approved in Telecom Order CRTC 2003-425 for LondonConnect Inc.
- 3. The Commission **approves on an interim basis** Bell Canada's application. The revisions take effect as of the date of this Order.
