CJAT-FM Trail – New transmitter in Castlegar

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Standard Radio Inc. (Standard) to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CJAT-FM Trail, in order to operate a transmitter in Castlegar.
- 2. The new transmitter will operate at 90.3 MHz (channel 212A1) with an effective radiated power of 230 watts.
- 3. The Commission received interventions in support of this application.
- 4. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
- 5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
- 6. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before 5 April 2008. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
