CBKF-FM Regina and its transmitter CBKF-FM-5 North Battleford – Technical change

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) to change the authorized contours of its transmitter CBKF-FM-5 North Battleford, by increasing the effective radiated power from 4,300 watts to 9,600 watts and by increasing the antenna height.
- 2. The CBC indicated that these changes reflect CBKF-FM-5's technical parameters following the installation of a new antenna with elliptical polarization. The new antenna enables the CBC to offer its La Première Chaîne service originating from CBKF-FM-5 with its new Radio Two service at North Battleford.
- 3. The Commission notes that the new technical parameters will result in negligible change in coverage.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
