CICY-FM Selkirk and its transmitters – Licence renewal

- 1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the English- and Native-language Type B native FM radio programming undertaking CICY-FM Selkirk and its transmitters CIPM-FM Peguis and CIFR-FM Fairford, from 1 September 2006 to 31 August 2013.
- 2. The Commission received one intervention in support of this application.
- 3. The licence will be subject to the **conditions** specified therein as well as to the following **conditions**:
 - The licensee shall broadcast no more than an average of 4 minutes of advertising per hour per day, with a maximum of 6 minutes in any given hour, in accordance with *Native Broadcasting Policy*, Public Notice CRTC 1990-89, 20 September 1990.
 - The licensee shall adhere to the guidelines on gender portrayal set out in the Canadian Association of Broadcasters' (CAB) *Sex-role portrayal code for television and radio programming*, as amended from time to time and approved by the Commission.
 - The licensee shall adhere to the provisions of the CAB's Broadcast code for advertising to children, as amended from time to time and approved by the Commission.
