- 2. The first sentence of paragraph 1 should read as follows:

High Fidelity HDTV Inc., on behalf of a corporation to be incorporated, filed an application for a broadcasting licence to operate Horror HD, a national, high definition, English-language Category 2 specialty service devoted to horror and thriller movies and other programming, such as magazine style shows, dedicated to horror and thriller subject matters.

3. The first sentence of paragraph 9 should read as follows:

Based on the foregoing, the Commission is satisfied that the proposed service would not be directly competitive with TMN or MPix or with other existing Category 1 or analog pay or specialty services and that the application is consistent with Public Notice 2000-6.
