CBH-FM Halifax – New transmitter at Yarmouth

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CBH-FM Halifax, in order to operate a transmitter at Yarmouth to rebroadcast the programming of its national, English-language network service Radio Two.
- 2. The new transmitter will operate at 98.5 MHz (channel 253B) with an average effective radiated power of 19,900 watts.
- 3. The Commission received one intervention in support of this application.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
- 5. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before **12 December 2009**. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
