CFXM-FM Granby - Technical change

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Coopérative de travail de la radio de Granby to change the authorized contours of the French-language commercial FM radio programming undertaking CFXM-FM Granby by increasing the average effective radiated power from 200 watts to 1,184 watts, by increasing the effective antenna height from 341 to 356 metres and by relocating the transmitter.
- 2. The applicant stated that these changes will allow it to improve its service to the Granby market.
- 3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
- 4. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
- 5. The Commission reminds the licensee that pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
