2. These licences will be subject to the **conditions** set out in Public Notice 1999-137, with the exception of condition no. 5 and of condition no. 1, the latter of which is replaced by the following **condition**:



If the licensee originates 42 or more hours of programming in any broadcast week, the licensee shall adhere to the Canadian Association of Broadcasters' *Equitable Portrayal Code*, as amended from time to time and approved by the Commission. However, the application of the foregoing condition of licence will be suspended if the licensee is a member in good standing of the Canadian Broadcast Standards Council.

- 3. The Commission reminds the licensees that, as of 1 September 2008, they will be required to adhere to the requirements relating to contributions to Canadian content development set out in section 15 of the *Radio Regulations*, 1986, as amended by *Regulations Amending the Radio Regulations*, 1986, SOR/2008-177, 28 May 2008, announced in Broadcasting Public Notice 2008-67.
- 4. The Commission did not receive any interventions with respect to these applications.

Employment equity

- 5. Because the licensees Maritime Broadcasting System Limited and Rawlco Radio Ltd. are subject to the *Employment Equity Act* and file reports concerning employment equity with the department of Human Resources and Social Development Canada, their employment equity practices are not examined by the Commission.
- 6. In accordance with Public Notice 1992-59, the Commission encourages the remaining licensees to consider employment equity issues in their hiring practices and in all other aspects of their management of human resources.
