## CHHA Toronto – Technical amendment

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by San Lorenzo Latin American Community Centre to amend the broadcasting licence for the Type B community AM radio programming undertaking CHHA Toronto to change the authorized contours by modifying the antenna radiation pattern from non-directional to directional and by modifying its transmitter power from 10,000 watts day-time and 1,000 watts night-time to 6,250 watts day- and night-time.
- 2. The Commission received interventions in support of this application. The public record for this proceeding is available on the Commission's website at www.crtc.gc.ca under "Public Proceedings."
- 3. The licensee stated that such a change in transmitter power would allow the station to regain lost listenership resulting from the night-time power reduction and that the change in antenna radiation pattern would protect other AM stations from skywave interference.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
