CIAM-FM-12 Cleardale - Technical change

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by the CIAM-FM Media & Radio Broadcasting Association to change the authorized contours of its transmitter CIAM-FM-12 Cleardale by decreasing the antenna's effective height above average terrain from 48.5 to 39.07 metres and relocating the transmitter site. The Commission did not receive any interventions concerning this application.
- 2. The applicant stated the change was necessary due to a lack of space on the tower that was originally proposed.
- 3. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
