Gosfield North Communications Co-operative Limited – Increase to local residential service rate

File number: Tariff Notice 18

- 1. The Commission received an application from Gosfield North Communications Co-operative Limited (Gosfield), dated 4 April 2012, proposing a revision to item 4 of its General Tariff Rate Schedules for Primary Exchange (Local) Service, in order to increase the rate for residential individual-line service.
- 2. Specifically, the company proposed to raise the monthly rate for residential individual-line service from \$23.95 to \$25.95, consistent with determinations made in Telecom Regulatory Policy 2011-291.
- 3. Gosfield stated that it had implemented the new monthly rate of \$25.95 on 1 August 2011, but that due to an oversight on its part, it did not file a tariff notice at that time requesting the Commission's approval of the new rate. Accordingly, the company requested that the Commission ratify the charging of the rate of \$25.95 from 1 August 2011 to the date of the order, pursuant to subsection 25(4) of the *Telecommunications Act* (the Act).
- 4. The Commission approved Gosfield's application on an interim basis in Telecom Order 2012-232, noting that in Telecom Regulatory Policy 2011-291 it determined that the small incumbent local exchange carriers would be allowed to increase their monthly residential rates to a maximum of \$30 over a three year period. The Commission also noted that it would address the company's request for ratification in the final order.
- 5. With respect to Gosfield's ratification request, the Commission notes that, pursuant to subsection 25(4) of the Act, it may ratify the charging of a rate by a Canadian carrier otherwise than in accordance with a tariff approved by the Commission if it is satisfied that the rate was charged because of an error or other circumstance that warrants the ratification.
- 6. The Commission is satisfied that Gosfield charged the rate of \$25.95 without an approved tariff due to an error. The Commission therefore considers that the company's request for ratification is reasonable.



7. Accordingly, the Commission **approves on a final basis** Gosfield's application to increase the rate for residential individual-line service to \$25.95, effective 14 June 2012, and ratifies the rate of \$25.95 charged by the company from 1 August 2011 to 19 April 2012.
