Decision of the Broadcasting Arbitrator

1. On 3 March 2023, the Broadcasting Arbitrator released an order with respect to the Re-Allocation of Paid Time. This order, made pursuant to section 335 and subsection 340(1) and 343(2) of the *Canada Elections Act* (the Act), replaces the 2022 Allocation of Paid Time.
2. The Commission is required, pursuant to subsection 342(1) of the Act, to notify broadcasters and network operators of such allocations.
