CJRY-FM Edmonton – Technical change

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Touch Canada Broadcasting Inc. to change the authorized contours of the radio programming undertaking CJRY-FM Edmonton, authorized in *Christian music FM radio station in Edmonton*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2003-1, 7 January 2003, by increasing the antenna height from 138.5 metres to 193 metres and relocating the transmitter to a site approximately 19 kilometres northeast of the current site.
- 2. For economic reasons, the licensee requested that it be allowed to locate its transmitter on the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation's tower.
- 3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
- 4. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
- 5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
