Deadline to file an application for a new FM frequency

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Aboriginal Voices Radio Inc. (AVR) for an extension of the time limit to submit an application for the use of a frequency other than 100.1 MHz to operate its new radio programming undertaking in Montréal. The Commission approved AVR's application for the new service in *Native FM radio station in Montréal*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2003-195, 2 July 2003, but directed the applicant to submit an amendment to the proposed technical parameters predicated on the use of another frequency.
- 2. This is the applicant's fourth request for an extension of the time limit to submit an application for the use of an alternate frequency.
- 3. The Commission grants the applicant an extension to 2 July 2005 to file an application proposing the use of another frequency that is acceptable to both the Commission and the Department of Industry, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before that date.
