CKCL-FM Chilliwack and its transmitter CKCL-FM-2 Vancouver – Technical change

1. The Commission **approves** the application by Rogers Broadcasting Limited to change the authorized contours of its transmitter CKCL-FM-2 Vancouver, by increasing the average effective radiated power from 14,100 watts to 16,100 watts.
2. The licensee indicated that the increase in power is the result of technical changes to the antenna system that will improve its service in the downtown core of Vancouver.
3. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
