## CJFW-FM Terrace and its transmitter CJFW-FM-1 Kitimat – Technical changes

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Standard Radio Inc. (Standard), the licensee of the radio programming undertaking CJFW-FM Terrace, to change the authorized contours of its transmitter CJFW-FM-1 Kitimat, by increasing the effective radiated power from 50 watts to 170 watts, by decreasing the antenna height and by relocating the transmitter. Standard stated that the current tower is being dismantled.
- 2. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
- 3. The Commission notes that the authorized contour of the transmitter will increase significantly as a result of the technical changes approved in this decision and that CJFW-FM-1's status will change from that of a low-power unprotected service to that of a regular Class A1 transmitter.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
