Revocation of licence

- In CJCI Prince George Conversion to FM band, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2002-421, 10 December 2002, the Commission approved an application by Cariboo Central Interior Radio Inc. for a broadcasting licence to operate an FM radio programming undertaking at Prince George to replace its AM station CJCI. The new FM station is now in operation.
- 2. Cariboo Central Interior Radio Inc. has now requested the revocation of its licence for the radio programming undertaking CJCI Prince George.
- 3. Given the licensee's request, the Commission **revokes**, pursuant to sections 9(1)(e) and 24(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, the broadcasting licence issued to Cariboo Central Interior Radio Inc. for CJCI Prince George.
