## **Deadline to commence operations**

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Newcap Inc. (originally filed by Sask-Alta Broadcasters Limited<sup>1</sup>) for an extension of the time limit to commence the operation of the transmitter CKSA-FM-1 Bonnyville authorized in *CKSA Lloydminster Conversion to FM band*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2002-461, 18 December 2002.
- 2. The Commission notes that this is the licensee's second request for an extension to implement its authority.
- 3. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 18 December 2006, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before that date. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
