Further to its Broadcasting Notices of Public Hearing CRTC 2005-7, 2005-7-1 and 2005-7-2 dated 28 July 2005, 2 August 2005 and 16 September 2005 relating to a Public Hearing which will be held on 3 October 2005 at 9:30 a.m., at the Best Western Charlottetown, 238 Grafton Street, Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, the Commission announces the following: The deadline for submission of interventions/comments for this application is extended to 26 September 2005.

CORRECTION TO ITEM NO. 9

New Glasgow, Nova Scotia
Application No. 2004-1354-2

Application by **Hector Broadcasting Company Limited** to convert radio station CKEC New Glasgow from the AM band to the FM band.

At the applicant's request the average effective radiated power and maximum effective radiated power of the proposed station has been changed to 36,680 watts and 80,000 watts respectively.

The original frequency (94.1 MHz), channel (231 C1) and antenna height of 207.8 meters remain unchanged. The application therefore remains technically mutually exclusive with items 6, 7, and 8 for use of the 94.1 MHz frequency.

Please note that the Commission will consider the interventions already received, accepted and filed on the public file for Broadcasting Notice of Public Hearing CRTC 2005-7.

Further to this amendment, the Commission will accept interventions that only relate to the change in technical parameters.

Each paragraph of the document should be numbered.

Your intervention should clearly identify the application and indicate whether you support or oppose the application, or if you propose changes to it, include the facts and grounds for your proposal.

In the event that the application is brought to the oral phase of the hearing, and if you wish to appear, you must provide reasons why your written comments are not sufficient and why an appearance is necessary.

Persons requiring communications support such as assistance listening devices and sign language interpretation are requested to inform the commission at least twenty (20) days before the commencement of the public hearing so that the necessary arrangements can be made.
