### **CFMJ Toronto – Licence renewal**

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the English-language commercial radio programming undertaking CFMJ Toronto, from 1 September 2006 to 31 August 2013.
2. The Commission received one intervention in support of this application.
3. The licence will be subject to the **conditions** set out in *New licence form for commercial radio stations*, Public Notice CRTC 1999-137, 24 August 1999.
4. The Commission reminds the licensee of its on-going obligations, currently in place and set to expire in 2007, related to the benefits accepted in *Sale of WIC Premium Corporation approved, conditional upon the subsequent divestiture of that company's 50% voting interest in The Family Channel Inc.*, Decision CRTC 2000-222, 6 July 2000.
5. Because this licensee is subject to the *Employment Equity Act* and files reports concerning employment equity with the Department of Human Resources and Skills Development, its employment equity practices are not examined by the Commission.
