CFBX-FM Kamloops – Technical change

1. The Commission **approves** the application by The Kamloops Campus/Community Radio Society to change the authorized contours of the radio programming undertaking CFBX-FM Kamloops, by increasing the effective radiated power from 4.9 watts to 420 watts, by decreasing the antenna height and by relocating the transmitter.
2. The licensee stated that approval of this application would improve the reception of CFBX-FM throughout Kamloops.
3. The Commission notes that the increase in power will result in a change of CFBX-FM Kamloop's status from a low power unprotected service to a regular Class A service.
4. The Commission received interventions in support of this application.
5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
