## **CBM-FM Montréal – New transmitter at Iqaluit**

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CBM-FM Montréal in order to add an FM transmitter at Iqaluit to rebroadcast the programming of the CBC's national English-language network service, Radio Two.
- 2. The new transmitter will operate at 88.3 MHz (channel 202A) with an effective radiated power of 800 watts.
- 3. The Commission received an intervention in support of this application, and a comment addressing a matter not directly related to the CBC's application.
- 4. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
- 5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
