Application by **TELUS Communications Inc.** to amend its three Class 1 regional broadcasting licences for its cable broadcasting distribution undertakings (BDUs) serving the above-mentioned locations.

The licensee proposes to replace the current condition of licence for its BDUs serving these locations in the provinces of Quebec, Alberta and British Columbia which reads:

The licensee is authorized to receive directly through its own facilities, at its option, any of the distant Canadian signals that are otherwise required to be received from a licensed satellite relay distribution undertaking. The licensee is not authorized to use any facilities

other than its own for the reception of these signals. This condition does not authorize the licensee to provide these services to any other licensed or exempt distribution undertaking.

**with the following condition of licence:**

The licensee is authorized to receive directly through its own facilities, at its option, any of the distant Canadian **or U.S.** signals that are otherwise required to be received from a licensed satellite relay distribution undertaking. The licensee is not authorized to use any facilities other than its own for the reception of these signals. This condition does not authorize the licensee to provide these services to any other licensed or exempt distribution undertaking.

The licensee also proposes to replace the current condition of licence for its BDUs serving the above-mentioned locations in the provinces of Alberta and British Columbia which reads:

In addition to the services required or authorized to be distributed pursuant to the applicable section of the *Broadcasting Distribution Regulations*, the licensee is authorized, by condition of licence, to distribute, at its option, and as part of the basic service, the signals of KOMO-TV (ABC), KIRO-TV (CBS), KING-TV (NBC), KCPS-TV (PBS) Seattle and KCPQ (FOX) Tacoma, or alternatively for each signal, the signal of a different affiliate of the same network located in the same time zone as that of the licensed area and received from a licensed satellite relay distribution undertaking.

**with the following condition of licence:**

In addition to the services required or authorized to be distributed pursuant to the applicable section of the *Broadcasting Distribution Regulations*, the licensee is authorized, by condition of licence, to distribute, at its option, and as part of the basic service, the signals of KOMO-TV (ABC), KIRO-TV (CBS), KING-TV (NBC), **KCTS-TV** (PBS) Seattle and KCPQ (FOX) Tacoma, or alternatively for each signal, the signal of a different affiliate of the same network located in the same time zone as that of the licensed area and **included in the list of eligible satellite services, as amended from time to time. (emphasis added)**

The licensee states that the amendments sought would permit it to receive U.S. signals using its national fibre network and to redistribute those signals to its cable BDUs.

Application by **Novus Entertainment Inc.** (Novus) to amend the broadcasting licence of its Class 1 cable broadcasting distribution undertaking serving the Greater Vancouver Regional District.

The licensee is requesting to be relieved, by condition of licence, of the requirement pursuant to section 17 of the *Broadcasting Distribution Regulations* to distribute the local television station CHNU-TV Fraser Valley (known as OMNI BC).

Novus stated poor reception quality of OMNI BC's signal at Vancouver, and the lack of demand from its subscribers, as the reasons for its application.
