1. **Moncton, New Brunswick** **Application No. 2007-0554-3**

Application by **International Harvesters for Christ Evangelistic Association Inc.** to amend the licence of the English-language specialty radio programming undertaking CITA-FM Moncton, New Brunswick.

The licensee proposes to amend the licence by changing the frequency from 105.9 MHz (channel 290LP) to 105.1 MHz (channel 286A).

The licensee also proposes to change the authorized contours by increasing the effective radiated power from 50 to 880 watts (non-directional antenna) and by increasing the effective antenna height to 82.5 metres.

The authorized contours of the station will be increased significantly resulting from the proposed technical changes.

The Commission notes that the increase in power would result in a change of the CITA-FM status from a low-power unprotected service to a regular Class A service.

The licensee stated that pursuant to Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2007-8, 8 January 2007, the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation has been granted the frequency 106.1 MHz in the Moncton market and this will displace CITA-FM which operates on 105.9 MHz. The licensee also advised that over the years listeners have requested that it apply for a higher power. In order to be responsible to CITA-FM's listeners, the licensee has filed this application.

Application by the **Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC)** to amend the licence of the radio programming undertaking CBBX-FM Sudbury, Ontario.

The licensee proposes to add an FM transmitter at Timmins to broadcast the programming service of Espace musique originating from CBBX-FM Sudbury in order to serve the population of Timmins.

The transmitter would operate on frequency 105.7 MHz (channel 289B) with an effective radiated power of 37,800 watts (non-directional antenna/effective antenna height of 98.5 metres).
