CFEP-FM Eastern Passage – Licence renewal

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the English-language Type B community radio programming undertaking CFEP-FM Eastern Passage, from 1 September 2008 to 31 August 2015. The licence will be subject to the **conditions** set out in the appendix to this decision.
2. Community radio licensees have the flexibility to reduce or increase their weekly broadcast time by up to 20% without application to the Commission. A change of more than 20%, however, requires prior Commission approval.
3. The Commission received an intervention in support of this application.

Conditions of licence and encouragement for the English language Type B community radio programming undertaking CFEP-FM Eastern Passage, Nova Scotia

Conditions of licence

1. The licence will be subject to the conditions set out in *New licence form for community radio stations*, Public Notice CRTC 2000-157, 16 November 2000.
2. The licensee shall devote, in each broadcast week, 12% or more of its musical selections from content category 3 (Special Interest Music) to Canadian selections broadcast in their entirety.

Encouragement

Employment equity

The Commission considers that community radio stations should be particularly sensitive to employment equity issues in order to reflect fully the communities they serve.
