CFNR-FM Terrace – New transmitter in Smithers

1. The Commission **approves** the application by Northern Native Broadcasting (Terrace, B.C.) to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CFNR-FM Terrace in order to operate a transmitter in Smithers.
2. The new transmitter will operate at 95.1 MHz (channel 236LP) with an average effective radiated power of 16.7 watts.
3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
4. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
6. Given that the technical parameters approved in this decision are for a low-power unprotected FM service, the Commission also reminds the licensee that it will have to select another frequency if the Department so requires.
