### **VF2521 Surrey – Licence renewal**

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the English-language, low-power FM radio programming undertaking VF2521 Surrey, from 1 June 2008<sup>1</sup> to 31 August 2014.
2. The Commission notes that the licensee has resolved the technical impediments mentioned in *Administrative renewals*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2007-346, 30 August 2007. Also, the Department of Industry has confirmed that it will issue a broadcasting certificate.
3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
4. The licence will be subject to the **conditions** set out in *A licensing policy for low-power radio broadcasting*, Public Notice CRTC 1993-95, 28 June 1993, as well as to the following **conditions**:
  - The licensee must use the station solely for the purpose of broadcasting tourist information to visitors arriving in Surrey.
  - The licensee shall broadcast no more than six minutes of advertising material in each clock hour.

- The licensee shall not broadcast musical selections, except as incidental background music.
