



Telecom Order CRTC 2008-332

Ottawa, 12 December 2008

Téléphone Milot inc. – Modifications to residential calling features bundles

Reference: Tariff Notice 41

1. The Commission received an application by Téléphone Milot inc. (TMI), dated 27 August 2008, in which the company proposed revisions to General Tariff item 2.13.2.5 – *Forfait économique*, a residential calling features bundle. Specifically, TMI proposed to add voice mail to the list of features that are available to customers who subscribe to this bundle. TMI also submitted that the introduction of the *Forfait économique* bundle had rendered obsolete General Tariff item 2.13.6.3(a) – *Indispensable*, another residential calling features bundle, and, accordingly, proposed to withdraw it.
2. The Commission received no comments regarding this application. The public record of this proceeding, which closed on 19 November 2008, is available on the Commission's website at www.crtc.gc.ca under "Public Proceedings."

Commission's analysis and determinations

3. The Commission considers that making voice mail available as part of the *Forfait économique* bundle will benefit subscribers and, therefore, that it would be appropriate to approve the proposed revisions to that bundle.
4. In Telecom Decision 2008-22, the Commission revised the procedures for applications dealing with the destandardization and/or withdrawal of tariffed services. Companies proposing to withdraw a tariffed service are required to provide the Commission with, among other things, a proposed date for withdrawal, the number of customers affected, and a copy of the notice to affected customers. The Commission notes that TMI's application meets these requirements.
5. The Commission also notes that Telecom Decision 2008-22 encouraged companies to identify any substitute services, where available, to their customers and to manage customer transition to these services. In this regard, the Commission notes that TMI proposed to automatically migrate customers from the *Indispensable* bundle to the *Forfait économique* bundle. The *Forfait économique* bundle offers customers the choice of any five calling features, except call trace. Subject to the inclusion of the voice mail option referred to above, this bundle includes all of the functionalities covered by the *Indispensable* bundle and also provides customers with two extra features at the same monthly rate of \$9.95.
6. Accordingly, the Commission considers that TMI has fulfilled the requirements set out in Télécom Decision 2008-22 and that its application to withdraw the *Indispensable* bundle is acceptable.

7. In light of the above, the Commission **approves** TMI's application effective the date of this Order.
