The licensee proposes to replace the condition of licence relating to closed captioning which reads:

Condition no. 8 CRTC 2002-203

No later than 1 September 2006 and until the end of the licence term, the licensee shall caption at least 90% of all programs it airs during the broadcast day.

with the following condition:

The licensee shall close caption at least 90% of programs it airs during the broadcast day with the exception of adult movies and programs for pre-school children.

The licensee makes this request to alleviate the costs of close captioning stating that the costs due to close captioning exceed the service provided to the public. The other reason, according to the licensee, is the administrative burden.

According to the licensee, the financial resources will be reallocated to improving the quantity and quality of programming including close captioning of programs targeting the general public.

Applications by **Care Radio Broadcasting Association**, to amend the licence of the Type B English-language FM community radio programming undertaking CIAM-FM Fort Vermilion, Alberta.

The licensee proposes to add low-power FM transmitters at Meander River, Peerless Lake, Manning, Cleardale, Chateh, Wabasca and Fort Chipewyan, Alberta to broadcast the programming of CIAM-FM in order to serve the population of the areas.

The transmitter at Meander River would operate on frequency 95.9 MHz (channel 240LP) with an effective radiated power of 50 watts (non-directional antenna/effective antenna height of 44.25 metres).

The transmitter at Peerless Lake would operate on frequency 96.9 MHz (channel 245LP) with an effective radiated power of 50 watts (non-directional antenna/effective antenna height of 23 metres).

The transmitter at Manning would operate on frequency 95.5 MHz (channel 238LP) with an effective radiated power of 50 watts (non-directional antenna/effective antenna height of 42.2 metres).

The transmitter at Cleardale would operate on frequency 91.5 MHz (channel 218LP) with an effective radiated power of 50 watts (non-directional antenna/effective antenna height of 48.5 metres).

The transmitter at Chateh would operate on frequency 96.9 MHz (channel 245LP) with an effective radiated power of 14 watts (non-directional antenna/effective antenna height of 119.5 metres).

The transmitter at Wabasca would operate on frequency 95.5 MHz (channel 238LP) with an effective radiated power of 45 watts (non-directional antenna/effective antenna height of 63.25 metres).

The transmitter at Fort Chipewyan would operate on frequency 95.5 MHz (channel 238LP) with an effective radiated power of 30 watts (non-directional antenna/effective antenna height of 79.5 metres).

The licensee argues that the Northern communities in Alberta are closely connected and that many people spend hours driving to and from the villages within the areas sought to be served. The licensee expressed the desire to re-broadcast the CIAM signal so that the northern area will be covered from an overall community perspective.
