The licensee proposes to add a condition of licence relating to retention of program logs, which reads:

The licensee is relieved from the requirements of sections 10(1) to 10(4) of the *Television Broadcasting Regulations, 1987* with regard to the retention of program logs or records.

Since the licensee is a non-profit organization and CHCT-TV is a low-power station serving the community, the licensee states that it needs this amendment due to limited volunteer manpower.

2. **Sudbury, Ontario**

Application by **Newcap Inc.** to amend the licence of the English-language commercial FM radio programming undertaking CHNO-FM Sudbury.

The licensee proposes to amend the technical parameters of CHNO-FM by increasing the effective radiated power from 11,000 watts to 100,000 watts, by increasing the effective antenna height above average terrain from 120.9 metres to 203.5 metres and by relocating the transmitter.

The licensee states that the proposed changes are required to improve poor signal reception and reduce interference experienced due to a mountainous terrain and its present antenna location. The licensee also states that the proposed changes will allow colocation with its broadcasting undertaking CIGM-FM.

Application by **CIAM Media & Radio Broadcasting Association** to amend the licence of the radio programming undertaking CIAM-FM Fort Vermillion, Alberta.

The licensee proposes to change the authorized contours of its rebroacaster CIAM-FM-5 Weberville, Alberta, by decreasing the effective height of antenna above average terrain from 74 metres to 30 metres and by relocating the transmitter to another antenna site. All other technical parameters remain unchanged.

The licensee states that the above relocation of transmitter is necessary due to inferior tower structure.

A true copy must be sent to the applicant, and proof that this has been done must accompany the intervention sent to the Commission.

Parties must ensure, before initiating service through electronic mode, that they will be able to satisfy the Commission, upon request, that service of the notification was completed.

Each paragraph of the document should be numbered.

Interventions should clearly identify the application referred to and indicate whether they support or oppose the application, or, if they propose changes to it, include the facts and grounds for their proposal.
