### **CKSA-TV Lloydminster – Licence amendment**

1. The Commission **approves** the application by Newcap Inc. to amend the broadcasting licence for the English-language conventional television programming undertaking CKSA-TV Lloydminster to add a post-transition digital transmitter to serve the population of Lloydminster. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
2. The transmitter will operate on channel 2 with an effective radiated power of 8,100 watts (non-directional antenna with an effective height of antenna above average terrain of 220.6 metres).
3. The Commission reminds the licensee that pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, the licence amendment will not be in effect until the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
4. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 31 August 2011. The Commission expects the licensee to inform it in writing once this transmitter is in operation.
