### **CKTV-TV Saguenay – Licence amendment**

1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) to amend the broadcasting licence for the French-language conventional television programming undertaking CKTV-TV Saguenay in order to add a post-transition digital transmitter to serve the population of Saguenay (Jonquière Borough).
2. The new post-transition digital transmitter, CKTV-DT, will operate on channel 12 with an average effective radiated power (ERP) of 3,100 watts (maximum ERP of 7,400 watts with an effective height of antenna above average terrain of 581.1 metres).
3. The Commission received an intervention in opposition to this application as it relates to the proposed reduction in coverage. The Commission considers that the proposed coverage sufficiently reproduces the analog coverage. 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, the licence amendment will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
5. The new digital transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 31 August 2011. The Commission expects the licensee to inform it in writing once this transmitter is in operation.
