### **Execulink Telecom Inc. – Withdrawal of Switch 56 Data Service, Telephone Number Access Service, and ISP Link Service**

File number: Tariff Notice 64

1. The Commission received an application by Execulink Telecom Inc. (Execulink), dated 29 September 2011, in which the company proposed revisions to its General Tariff. Specifically, the company proposed to withdraw the following services:
  - Section 490, Item 12.03 – Switch 56 Data Service;
  - Section 830, Telephone Number Access Service; and
  - Section 900, Item 7 – Internet Service Provider (ISP) Link Service.
2. Execulink indicated that Switch 56 Data Service and Telephone Number Access Service have become obsolete and have had no demand for a number of years. The company also indicated that no customers have ever subscribed to ISP Link Service.
3. The Commission approved Execulink’s application on an interim basis in Telecom Order 2011-646, effective 29 November 2011.
4. The Commission received no comments regarding Execulink’s application. The public record of this proceeding, which closed on 14 November 2011, is available on the Commission’s website at [www.crtc.gc.ca](http://www.crtc.gc.ca) under “Public Proceedings” or by using the file number provided above.
5. The Commission considers that Execulink has complied with the requirements set out in Telecom Decision 2008-22, in which the Commission revised its procedures for dealing with applications to destandardize and/or withdraw tariffed services. The Commission also considers that since Switch 56 Data Service and Telephone Number Access Service have become obsolete and have had no demand for a number of years, and that since ISP Link Service has had no subscribers, customer notification was not required.
6. Accordingly, the Commission finds that Execulink’s proposal to withdraw the above-noted services is acceptable.
7. In light of the above, the Commission **approves on a final basis** Execulink’s application, effective the date of this order.
