CFNO-FM Marathon and its transmitters – Licence renewal

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the English-language commercial radio programming undertaking CFNO-FM Marathon and its transmitters CFNO-FM-1 Nipigon/Red Rock, CFNO-FM-2 Hornepayne, CFNO-FM-4 Geraldton, CFNO-FM-5 Longlac, CFNO-FM-7 Nakina and CFNO-FM-8 White River from 1 December 2012 to 31 August 2019.¹ The terms and **condition of licence** are set out in the appendix to this decision. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
2. In Broadcasting Decision 2008-363, the Commission granted CFNO-FM and its transmitters a short-term licence renewal for a period of four years based on its failure to comply with its obligations relating to Canadian talent development and with sections 2.2(8) and 2.2(9) of the *Radio Regulations, 1986* (the Regulations) with respect to Canadian content for category 2 musical selections.
3. The Commission finds that during the current licence term, the licensee has operated its undertaking in a manner consistent with its conditions of licence as well as the Regulations, and that it has addressed the concerns previously raised by the Commission in Broadcasting Decision 2008-363.
4. In accordance with Public Notice 1992-59, the Commission also encourages the licensee to consider employment equity issues in its hiring practices and in all other aspects of its management of human resources.

Terms and condition of licence

Terms

The licence will take effect 1 December 2012 and expire 31 August 2019.

Condition of licence

1. The licensee shall adhere to the standard conditions of licence set out in *Conditions of licence for commercial AM and FM radio stations*, Broadcasting Regulatory Policy CRTC 2009-62, 11 February 2009.
