CBCL-FM London – New transmitter in Tillsonburg

1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CBCL-FM London, Ontario, in order to operate a transmitter in Tillsonburg to rebroadcast the programming of its national English-language network service Radio One. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
2. The new transmitter will operate at 88.7 MHz (channel 204B1) with an average effective radiated power (ERP) of 2,060 watts (maximum ERP of 8,180 watts) with an effective height of antenna above average terrain of 78.9 metres.¹
3. The licensee stated that this amendment will improve the Radio One network coverage in Tillsonburg and in the southern part of Ontario.
4. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before **7 March 2016**. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
