CBXV-FM Fox Creek –Technical changes

1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) to change the authorized contours of CBXV-FM Fox Creek, a transmitter for the English-language radio programming undertaking CBX Edmonton, by changing the antenna's radiation pattern from non-directional to directional, increasing its average effective radiated power (ERP) from 38 to 93 watts (maximum ERP from 38 to 260 watts), decreasing its effective height above average terrain from 54 to 27.9 metres and changing its class from A1 to A. The Commission did not receive any interventions regarding this application.
2. The CBC stated that the technical changes would improve the transmitter's coverage in the Fox Creek region.
3. The Commission reminds the licensee that pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
