CJSW-FM Calgary – Technical changes

1. The Commission **approves** the application by The University of Calgary Student Radio Society to change the authorized contours of the community-based campus radio programming undertaking CJSW-FM Calgary, Alberta, to increase the average effective radiated power from 4,000 watts to 18,000 watts (non-directional antenna) and to change the class from B to C1. The Commission received several interventions in support of this application.
2. The licensee indicated that these changes are necessary to reduce interference resulting from the entry of new high-power radio stations on the FM band in Calgary.
3. The Commission reminds the licensee that pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
