### Various terrestrial and direct-to-home pay-per-view services – Licence renewal

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licences for the national terrestrial and direct-to-home (DTH) pay-per-view services set out below from 1 September 2014 to 31 August 2019. The five-year term is consistent with the approach that the Commission has taken for other services controlled by large ownership groups.

2. The Commission received an intervention from Entertainment One in support of the Shaw application. The Commission received a comment from the Canadian Energy Efficiency Alliance (CEEA) related to all six services as well as a comment from the Alberta Energy Efficiency Alliance (AEEA) related to the Shaw application. Bell ExpressVu replied to the CEEA intervention and Shaw replied to the CEEA and AEEA interventions. The Commission considers that the comments by the CEEA and AEEA, which deal with energy consumption by set-top boxes, fall outside the scope of this proceeding.
