CFJL-FM Winnipeg – Technical changes

1. The Commission **approves** the application by Dufferin Communications Inc. to amend the broadcasting licence for the English-language commercial radio programming undertaking CFJL-FM Winnipeg, Manitoba, by changing its frequency from 100.7 MHz (channel 264C1) to 100.5 MHz (channel 263C1), and to change the station's authorized contours by increasing the average effective radiated power (ERP) from 51,000 to 63,500 watts (maximum ERP from 80,000 to 100,000 watts). The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
2. The licensee stated that these technical changes will improve the signal quality of the service in Winnipeg. It further stated that the requested technical changes (in particular, the change in frequency), combined with the Commission's prior approval for the station to no longer operate within the specialty format (see *CFJL-FM Winnipeg – Licence renewal and amendments*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2013-550, 11 October 2013), will enable it to better capitalize on the station's current Modern Easy Listening/Adult Contemporary format.
3. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
