### **CBV-FM Québec – New Transmitter in Baie-Saint-Paul**

1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CBV-FM Québec to operate an FM rebroadcasting transmitter in Baie-Saint-Paul, Quebec. This will allow listeners to receive ICI Radio-Canada Première's programming originating in Québec. The Commission did not receive any interventions regarding this application.
2. The new transmitter will operate at 104.9 MHz (channel 285) with an average effective radiated power (ERP) of 833 watts (maximum ERP of 3 597 watts with an effective height of antenna above average terrain of -127.1 metres).
3. The Commission reminds the licensee that pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
4. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before **29 September 2016**. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
