Changes to procedure

1. Further to Compliance and Enforcement Notice of Consultation 2015-333 (the Notice), and pursuant to section 37 of the *Telecommunications Act*,¹ the Commission is issuing, by letter today, further requests for information from the parties to the proceeding (i.e. those listed in Appendix 2 of the Notice) on barriers to the adoption of existing solutions or to the implementation of new and innovative solutions.
2. Accordingly, the Commission is extending the deadline for final submissions set out in the Notice. For ease of reference, the relevant paragraph of the Notice is reproduced below, with changes highlighted in bold italics.

20. All parties may file final submissions with the Commission on any matter within the scope of this proceeding by ***31 January 2016***. Final submissions, including an executive summary, are not to exceed 15 pages.
