CJDC-TV Dawson Creek and CFTK-TV Terrace – New transmitters in Fort St. John and Smithers

- The Commission approves the applications by Bell Media Inc. to amend the
 broadcasting licences for the television programming undertakings CJDC-TV Dawson
 Creek and CFTK-TV Terrace, British Columbia, in order to operate transmitters in Fort
 St. John and Smithers. This will enable viewers in Fort St. John to receive programming
 originating from CJDC-TV Dawson Creek and viewers in Smithers to receive
 programming originating from CFTK-TV Terrace. The Commission did not receive any
 interventions in connection with these applications.
- 2. The new transmitter in Fort St. John will operate on channel 9 with an average effective radiated power (ERP) of 180 watts (maximum ERP of 660 watts with an effective height of the antenna above average terrain (EHAAT) of 245.7 metres).
- 3. The new transmitter in Smithers will operate on channel 5 with an average ERP of 155 watts (maximum ERP of 622 watts with an EHAAT of 242 metres).
- 4. Pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that broadcasting certificates will be issued.
- 5. The transmitters must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before **12 December 2019**. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
