CBY Corner Brook – New transmitter in St. Anthony

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) to amend the broadcasting licence for the English-language radio programming undertaking CBY Corner Brook, Newfoundland and Labrador, to operate an FM transmitter in St. Anthony to rebroadcast the programming of its national, English-language network service Radio One. The new FM transmitter will replace the existing AM transmitter CBNA St. Anthony. The Commission did not receive any interventions regarding this application.
- 2. The new transmitter will operate at 100.3 MHz (channel 262A), with an effective radiated power of 4,500 watts (non-directional antenna with an effective height of the antenna above average terrain of 173 metres).
- 3. The CBC stated that the tower for the current transmitter is unstable and must be removed. The licensee also stated that the new FM transmitter will reach a greater population than the existing AM signal.
- 4. Pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
- 5. The transmitter must be in operation by no later than **5 February 2020**. To request an extension, the licensee must submit a written request to the Commission at least 60 days before that date, using the form available on the Commission's website.
