In *Bouchard Parent Associés Inc., operating as Royal LePage Tendance – Violations of the Unsolicited Telecommunications Rules*, Compliance and Enforcement Decision CRTC [2018-483](#), 19 December 2018 (Compliance and Enforcement Decision [2018-483](#)), the Commission inadvertently referred to paragraph 72.004(a) instead of paragraph 72.04(1)(a) of the *Telecommunications Act* in footnote 1.
2. Accordingly, footnote 1 of Compliance and Enforcement Decision [2018-483](#) is amended to read as follows (changes highlighted in bold):

¹ Paragraph **72.04(1)(a)** of the *Telecommunications Act* states that the Commission may designate **persons**, or **classes of persons, who are** authorized to issue notices of violation.
