Radiocommunication distribution undertaking in Mount Jubilee

1. The Commission **approves** the application by Noah Gehmair, in his capacity as Manager, Technology Infrastructure, Government of Yukon, for a broadcasting licence to operate a radiocommunication distribution undertaking (RDU) to serve Mount Jubilee, Yukon.¹ The Commission did not receive any interventions regarding this application.
2. The RDU will rebroadcast the signal of CFWH-FM Whitehorse to the community of Mount Jubilee in order to provide Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) Radio One programming to that community. A letter of support from the CBC was included with the application.
3. The undertaking will distribute the programming service of CBC Radio One at 103.1 MHz (channel 276A) with an average effective radiated power (ERP) of 340 watts (maximum ERP of 482 watts with an effective height of the antenna above average terrain of 271.45 metres).
4. Subject to the requirements set out in the appendix to this decision, the Commission will issue a broadcasting licence to the Manager of Technology Infrastructure, Government of Yukon, authorizing Mr. Gehmair in his capacity as the said Manager, and any subsequent person occupying that position,² to operate this undertaking.

¹ The Commission previously approved an identical application in *Radiocommunication distribution undertaking in Mount Jubilee*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2017-214, 22 June 2017. The approval granted in that decision was rendered invalid, because the applicant did not commence operations before the implementation deadline set out in the appendix to that decision, that is, before 22 June 2019.

² That person must be eligible to hold a broadcasting licence in accordance with the *Direction to the CRTC (Ineligibility of Non-Canadians)*.

5. The licence will expire 31 August 2026 and will be subject to the **conditions** therein as well as to the terms set out in the appendix to this decision.

Terms for the radiocommunication distribution undertaking to serve Mount Jubilee, Yukon

Terms

The licence will expire 31 August 2026.

The undertaking will operate at 103.1 MHz (channel 276A) with an average effective radiated power (ERP) of 340 watts (maximum ERP of 482 watts with an effective height of the antenna above average terrain of 271.45 metres).

Pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.

Furthermore, the Commission will only issue a licence for this undertaking once the applicant has informed the Commission in writing that it is prepared to commence operations. The undertaking must be in operation by no later than **3 June 2022**. To request an extension, the applicant must submit a written request to the Commission at least 60 days before that date, using the form available on the Commission's website.
