Various companies – Approval of tariff applications

1. The Commission **approves** the following tariff applications:

2. The Commission received no interventions with respect to these applications.
3. In accordance with subparagraph 1(b)(i) of the 2006 Policy Direction,¹ the Commission considers that the approval of these applications will advance the policy objective set out in paragraph 7(b) of the *Telecommunications Act*.²
4. In accordance with the 2019 Policy Direction,³ the Commission considers that this order, which is based on a complete record, can promote competition, affordability, consumer interests, and innovation. Specifically, the approval of these applications will promote consumer interests by ensuring that services that are no longer required are removed from this tariff while being moved to Bell Canada’s proposed National Services Tariff Item 769, which will provide a simpler and more consistent service offering across Bell Canada’s territories.
