CJLT-FM Medicine Hat – Acquisition of assets - Finalization of conditions of service

- 1. In *CJLT-FM Medicine Hat Acquisition of assets*, Broadcasting Regulatory Policy CRTC 2023-403, 4 December 2023 (Broadcasting Decision 2023-403), the Commission approved an application by United Christian Broadcasters Media Canada for authority to acquire from Vista Radio Ltd. the assets of the English-language commercial specialty (Religious music) radio station CJLT-FM Medicine Hat, Alberta, and for a new broadcasting licence to continue the operation of the station.
- 2. In that decision, the Commission proposed to make orders imposing on United Christian Broadcasters Media Canada various conditions of service set out in Appendix 2 to the decision and invited interested persons to make representations only on the proposed orders. The Commission did not receive any representations.
- 3. In light of the above, and pursuant to subsection 9.1(1) and 11.1(2) of the *Broadcasting Act*, the Commission hereby makes the **orders** imposing **conditions of service** on United Christian Broadcasters Media Canada in respect of the radio programming undertaking CJLT-FM Medicine Hat, as set out in Appendix 2 to Broadcasting Decision 2023-403.
