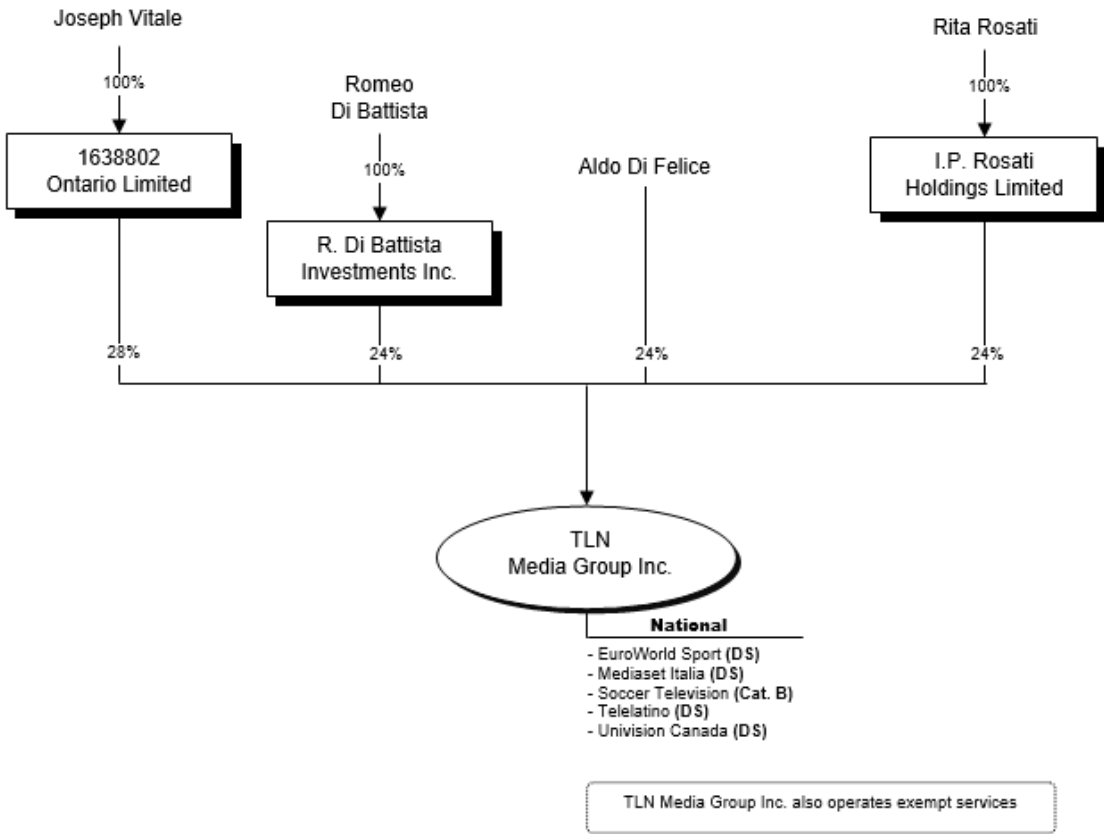

UPDATE

Update – 2019-02-11 – Telebimbi and TeleNiños are now operated as exempt services. Spanish Sports & Entertainment 1 service did not implement within the prescribed timeframe.

Administrative Decision – 2019-02-22 – approved a change in ownership and effective control of Telelatino Network Inc. through the transfer of all of the shares (50.5%) held by Corus Entertainment Inc. to a corporation to be incorporated (AcquisitionCo).

Update – 2019-11-27 – on 22 March 2019, Telelatino Network Inc. and TLN Media Group Inc. (previously AcquisitionCo) amalgamated to continue as TLN Media Group Inc.
